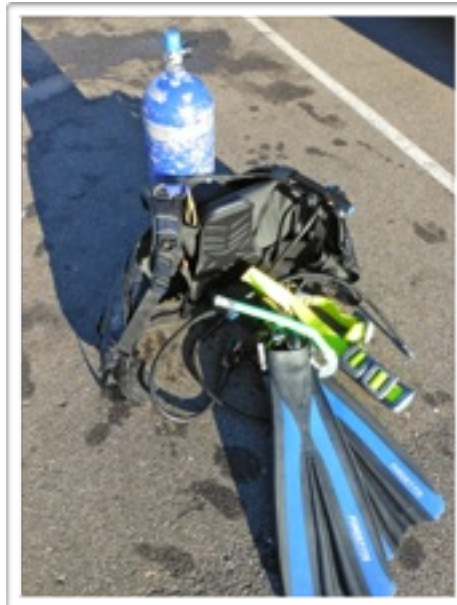




Video Tutorial Explanation - Putting the Equipment Together

As shown in the video, there are several components of the scuba equipment, and a specific order in which they all must be put together. Below is a step by step guide to putting the equipment together safely and in the correct order:

1) Lay out the equipment as shown:



2) Attach the BCD by inserting the tank into the two velcro hoops. Ensure the air valve is pointing to the right when the back of the BCD is facing you, as shown:



3) Tighten the hoops and secure with the velcro straps as shown:



4) Attach the regulator equipment, placing the first stage of your regulator onto the top of the air tank. When doing this, ensure that the first stage is fully undone so it can be placed easily onto the tank. Once on, tighten until finger tight, as shown:



5) Tuck away the octopus into the BCD so that the mouthpiece faces inwards, as shown:



- 6) Attach your inflator hose to your BCD by pulling back the silver slider, pushing the device into place and then releasing the slider. The slider will automatically spring back into its original position, locking your inflator to the valve of your BCD, as shown:



- 7) Now attach the inflator hose to your BCD by use of the velcro straps located on the left hand shoulder of your BCD, as shown:



- 8) Attach your depth and air supply gauge to the left hand shoulder strap of your BCD using the clip provided, as shown:



9) Clip your regulator hose to your BCD using the clip provided on the right shoulder of the BCD. This will prevent your regulator from floating out of arm's reach. Attach as shown:



10) Open the air valve on the air tank. Unscrew slowly at first so that the air is released gradually (about half a turn of gradual turning), then fully unscrew the valve. Once fully open, turn back by a quarter of a turn (so you know which way is fully open and you don't jam the tank open), as shown:



11) Put on a suitable weight belt around your waist. Feed the belt through the slit and fold it back on itself. Close the metal buckle to secure the belt, as shown:



12) Place the BCD and tank onto your back by putting your arms through the arm loops. Put your snorkel and mask around your neck and carrying your fins in your hand. You are now ready to go diving!
